



Applications Now Being Accepted

Firefighter/EMT-BLS & Firefighter/EMT-ALS (Full & Part-Time)

Botetourt County is accepting applications for a fulltime and part-time FF/EMT-BLS and FF/EMT-ALS positions. These positions will report directly to the Department of Fire and EMS, but will work closely with volunteer fire & EMS agencies. Duties will focus on the provisions of fire suppression and emergency medical care.

Minimum Requirements: 21 years of age, high school graduate or GED, valid non-restricted Virginia driver's license with good driving record, current EVOC (minimum of class 2). Must be currently certified as a Virginia EMT (BLS), EMT-I or P (ALS) with verifiable field experience and current CPR. PEPP, PHTLS, and ACLS (ALS) preferred. VDFP Firefighter I or NFPA 1001 equivalent required (preferred for part-time), FFII preferred. Must be able to pass a comprehensive medical exam. Will be required to perform all physical tasks associated with fire suppression, emergency medical services, and related activities.

Salary Range:

- Part-time: EMT-BLS- Starting Hourly Rate \$13.50
EMT-ALS- Starting Hourly Rate \$16.75
- Fulltime: FF/EMT-BLS- Starting Salary up to \$32,000 DOQ
FF/EMT-ALS-Starting Salary up to \$37,000 DOQ

Applications must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on Friday July 14th, 2017.

All applicants are required to be fingerprinted as part of the application process prior to the application deadline.
