



OFFICIAL VOTING INFORMATION
COUNTY OF BOTETOURT RESIDENTS
November 3, 2020 General Election



Deadline to Register to Vote in the November 3, 2020 General Election is Tuesday, October 13, 2020 @ 5:00 pm (in-person).

The Botetourt County Department of Elections & Voter Registration will be open until 5:00 pm on Tuesday, October 13, 2020 for the purpose of registering qualified persons. Individuals who will be 18-years of age on or before the November 3, 2020 General Election are eligible to register to vote. See note below.

CHANGE OF NAME OR ADDRESS: If you are currently a registered voter and have had a **change to your name or address**, you must notify the Registrar in writing, update your voter registration online or thru DMV, or appear in person in the Department of Elections & Voter Registration to update the information.

****Notifying the Post Office does NOT change your Voter Registration information****

NO-EXCUSE ABSENTEE: Absentee voting begins no later than Friday, September 18, 2020. All voters eligible to vote in the November 3, 2020 General Election may exercise their right during this period with out an excuse as previously required. Voters can submit applications online at vote.virginia.gov to have a ballot mailed or can vote in-person at our office. For the convenience of registered voters who need to vote by **absentee ballot**, the Voter Registration Office will be open from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm on **Saturday, October 24 and October 31, 2020 for in-person absentee voting**. Deadline to submit an application for a mailed ballot is Friday, October 23, 2020. Deadline to vote in-person absentee is Saturday, October 31, 2020 at 4:30 pm.

INTERESTED IN PARTICIPATING: Elections would not be possible without the participation of voters as election officials. These officials carry out important duties at each polling place to ensure the election is done efficiently and with integrity. We are looking for voters who would be interested in becoming election officials for upcoming elections. Come be a part of the elections in 2020 while enjoying camaraderie with fellow Botetourt County citizens. A stipend is paid based on participation. Please contact our office for more information.

POTENTIAL VOTERS WHO WILL BE 18 ON OR BEFORE November 3, 2020: If you will be 18 years of age on or before November 3, 2020 you are eligible to register to vote at any time prior to the registration deadline for the November 3, 2020 General Election. Registrations can be submitted online, via mail or in-person prior to the deadlines. Please contact our office should you have questions.
