

**RECREATION MAINTENANCE WORKER (Part-Time)**

**GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:**

Performs routine maintenance of athletic fields and facilities on a countywide level, does related work as required. Work is performed under the immediate supervision of Maintenance Supervisor or a Maintenance Crew Leader.

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:**

Work requires climbing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, standing, walking, pushing and pulling; vocal communication is required for expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word; hearing is required to perceive information at normal spoken word levels; visual acuity is required for use of measuring devices, operation of machines, operation of motor vehicles or equipment, determining the accuracy or thoroughness of work and observing general surroundings and activities; the work is subject to outside environmental conditions, extreme cold, extreme heat, hazards and atmospheric conditions. Participates in the maintenance and construction of all parks and recreation buildings, athletic fields and facilities, and equipment associated thereof. Employee may be subject to varying hours of work, including some nights and weekends.

**EXAMPLES OF WORK** *(Illustrative Only):*

Maintenance of athletic fields, park areas, and other County property for departmental sports leagues and general citizen use including mowing, trimming, laying out and marking fields for various sports, trash pickup, general cleaning of grounds, restrooms and concession stands.

Maintenance of indoor facilities for departmental sports leagues and general citizen use.

Performs maintenance/construction work relating to the Recreation Department and to recreation facilities.

Responsible for the care and maintenance of tools and equipment required to perform duties.

Prepares and paints interior and exterior buildings and equipment.

**REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:**

Some knowledge of soil and plant management, building and facility maintenance, and maintenance and operation of tools and equipment needed to perform aforementioned duties; a basic knowledge of sports and programs currently being conducted and preparation needed to adequately prepare facilities; ability to use hand, power, and motorized tools and equipment; ability to follow simple oral and written directions; possession of a valid drivers license and a good driving record; ability to work efficiently and effectively to meet required deadlines; ability to develop and maintain effective working relationships with other recreation employees, subordinates, other County departments and the general public.

**ACCEPTABLE EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:**

Some experience in facilities and grounds maintenance, tool and equipment operation in a park and recreation program with completion of a standard high school course, or any equivalent combination or experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities.
